Agreement With Henry Fleener and Elizabeth Haley for lease of a farm for her maintenance. This agreement entered into this 6th day of Nov. 1847 between Henry Fleener of the County of Roane and State of Tenn. of the one part and Elizabeth Haley of the County and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Henry Fleener hath this day rented of the said Elizabeth Haley the place on which she lives for and during the natural life of said Elizabeth Haley the said Fleener may cultivate or manage the said farm as he may think best provided he lets the said Elizabeth Haley live with him in the house that are now on the place and decently and comfortable maintain the said Elizabeth Haley and pay her twenty dollars yearly during her life what property the said Elizabeth Haley now has she is to have the control of and manage it as she pleases and have the privilege of raising stock if she desires to do. the said Henry Fleener is to pay the taxes of the said place and to treat the said Elizabeth Haley in a good, kind and comfortable manner. And at ~~the~~^{the} death of said Elizabeth Haley the said Henry Fleener is to have and keep all of her property that she may have at the time of her death. The said Elizabeth Haley is to keep or let the said Fleener remain in peaceable possession of the said farm. This obligation is to have effect and go into application on the first day of January 1848 for the performance of the above obligation we bind ourselves our heirs to each other in the sum of five hundred dollars in Witness whereof

Book - "History of Lincoln Co., Mo." - by Williams, Vol. I page 540 - "John Fleener, farmer, is a son of Nicholas + Nancy (Johnson) Fleener who were born in Va. + Indiana respectively. At an early day the father went to Indiana, was married there and followed agricultural pursuits in that state until 1851 when they moved to Lincoln Co. Mo. where the father died in 1872, age 81. He was a Democrat and an officer under Gen. Harrison, was wounded at the Battle of Tippecanoe and drew a pension. His wife was a member of the Baptist Church and died in 1884 at the age of 83. They had 15

Children, 12 sons and 3 daughters. Their son, John Fleener, born September 25, 1840 in Monroe Co., Indiana. He received a limited education, being 5 miles to school. At age 15 he began to learn the brick-layer's trade but soon turned to carpentering. From that he went to giving entertainments in sleight of hand and ventriloquism and was quite successful. In 1871 he married Miss Doucilla J. Murphy, they had 7 children, 2 sons and 5 daughters - 2 daughters being twins. Mrs. Fleener died in 1883. In 1885 he married Mrs. Margaret J. Cartwright, nee Skinner. Mr. & Mrs. Fleener are members of the Christian Church and he is a Democrat. He has 212 acres of land and 8 lots in Louisville and has been a resident of the County 37 years.
